Part 2 - Information for health and safety

To ensure health and safety standards are maintained:

All Committee Members – safety, risk assessments, consulting members, recording any accident, first aid.

Pete English – monitoring of risk assessments and any accident investigation.

All Committee Members – maintaining equipment, information, and basic training.

All members, visitors and guests should take reasonable care of their own health & safety.

Consultation:

• Members will be consulted on any new or changes to the Health and Safety information as they arise or formally when the Health and Safety information is reviewed annually.

Evacuation:

• In the event of a fire or incident, new members or guests will be informed of the location for the postcode to give to the emergency services.
