The content of this Member's Code of Conduct applies to all of our member

Respect the rights, dignity and worth of players (team-mates &

 opponents), Officials (umpires, coaches, organisers and managers) a spectators

Abide by the rules of pétanque:

- The Official Rules of the Game of Pétangue
- The EPA Compeon Rules
- At all mes observe the rules of the sport of pétanque and any addional rules for
- specific events or those implemented by the Officials on the day of an event

Respect and promote the spirit of fair play in pétanque

- Always play to the best of your ability and never directly or indirectly aempt to
- adversely influence an outcome of a game
 Always accept success and failure victory a
 - Always accept success and failure, victory and defeat with dignity and recognise
- achievements of others

Safety

- Take reasonable measures to protect your own safety and the safety of others
- Sports/Kit bags must not obstruct the pathway to the playing area and must be
- placed under the seats or on the boom table or hanging from the metal poles
 Children are to be supervised at ALL mes during pétanque play
- Wear protecve footwear when playing during pétanque play, open toe shoes ar
- not allowed on the pistes
 - Never parcipate when under the adverse influence of alcohol or recreaonal drugs

Personal Behaviour

- Take responsibility for your own acons
- Members, guests and visitors are expected to show respect to the piste grounds
- the appropriate use of all our facilies at all mes
 - Never engage in or condone inappropriate or abusive language or gestures,
- discriminaon, bullying, harassment, inmidaon or violence Never publicly cricise Players or Officials
- Never abuse a relaonship of trust, posion or power held at an individual, team,
- Club, Regional, Naonal or Inter-naonal level
 - TPC's reputaon: Do not act in a manner that will influence anything that will bring
- the Club into disrepute.
 - All members are responsible for the management and security of their own playi
- boules
 - Appropriate club dress is expected during compeons eg standard polo shirt
- Arrive for training and matches in good me to prepare thoroughly
- Pets are not allowed onto the pétanque playing area
- No Smoking or any form of electronic cigaree including vaping is allowed on or no
- the piste playing area
 - Remain hydrated parcularly during the summer months
- It is advisable to use a SPF when playing in the summer
 - Promote the reputaon of our Club and sport, taking reasonable steps to prevent them from being brought into disrepute
 - Set a posive example for others, especially young parcipants, beginners and
- spectators
 - Refrain from any acvity likely to bring disrepute on Players, Officials, Clubs, Region
- Events or the England Pétanque Associaon
